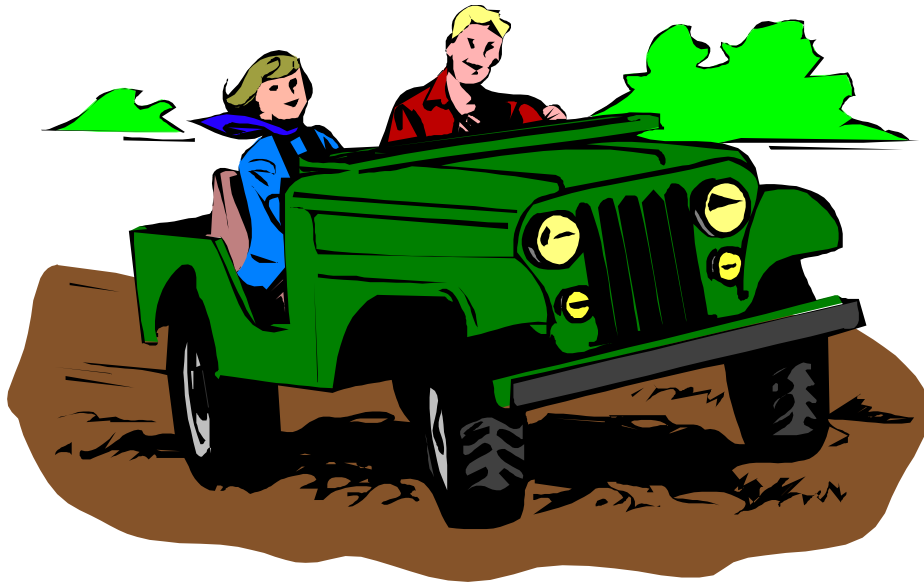


HAPPY TRAILS RV RESORT 4 – WHEEL DRIVE CLUB

Class 2 + Easy: High ground clearance required for stock two-wheel-drive pickups, vans, etc. Some mud holes or rocks that would stop most vehicles. Four-wheel-drive makes travel easy where others would have problems.

This ride is in the Guide To Arizona Backroads & 4-Wheel Drive Trails on page 157 trail # 40. **Bring warm jackets.** This trail is a BLM National Byway which climbs to 5681 feet. It is the highest mountain in southwestern Arizona. At the top you will find an observatory built by the Smithsonian Institution in use from 1920-25. Also are modern solar collectors used by the Central Arizona Project. This is a 10.6 mile trail each way. 6-8 hours back to Happy Trails.
